Ski Industry Reporting The 2nd-Busiest Season Ever! Eagle County Residential Sales Climbing Back.

A ski industry group's preliminary report says visits to U.S. ski resorts rose 4.2 % to 59.7 million last season. The National Ski Areas Association said that preliminary figures show the 2009-10 season was the second-best on record, after 60.5 million visits in the 2007-08 season.

As well, not only did Vail Resorts report a 2.3% increase in visits to its five ski mountains; but, also, the latest report from Land Title Guarantee Company said that the first quarter of 2010 was a great time for real estate sales in Eagle County. For March the dollar volume was the highest single-month figure in more than a year; and, the number of units sold was the highest since October of last year. Of all the residential transactions, almost half were for \$1 million or less.

We will again be handing out flags!**) **The 4th of July Concert** starts at 2 pm at the Gerald Ford Amphitheatre and the **Vail Village Fireworks** start at 9:45 pm at Golden Peak in Vail Village.

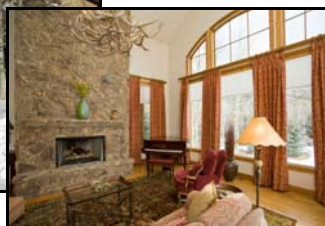
38th Annual Vail "King of the Mountain" Open June 18-20, 2010
