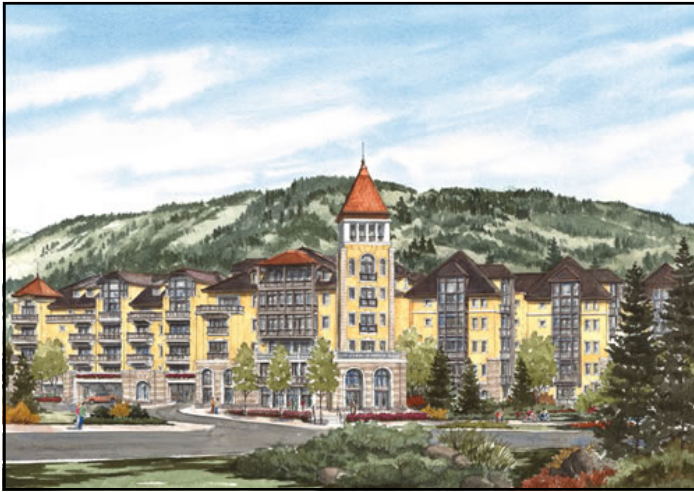

Vail's Chair 5 Gets Lift Towers

Vail's new High Noon Express lift on schedule to open this winter.

Twenty new lift towers installed on Vail Mountain are the first signs of shorter lift lines out of Vail's Sun up and Sun Down bowls this winter. The construction for Vail's new Chair 5, also known as the High Noon Express Lift, has been under way since the spring, when Vail Mountain removed the old chairlift and sent it to Nelson, British Columbia, where it's being installed at the Whitewater Ski Resort.

The new lift will be a huge addition for Vail Mountain. It is cutting the ride time out of Vail's Sun Up and Sun Down bowls in half, from 12 minutes down to 6 minutes and will allow skiers and riders to better enjoy Vail's Back Bowls. The new Chair 5 will be open this coming winter season, premiering as soon as snow permits the opening of Vail's Back Bowls.

The new lift is part of \$75 million to \$85 million in capital improvements at the company's resorts this summer. The old Chair 5, built in 1979, was a fixed-grip, three-seater – a slower lift that often resulted in long lines on weekends or powder days. The new Chair 5, a high-speed quad, will be able to carry 2,400 people per hour – 1,000 more people per hour than the old lift could handle.

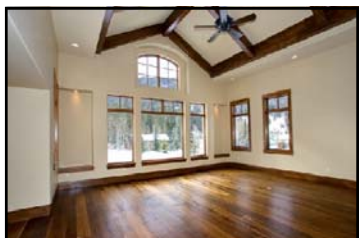
